Year 7 and Year 9

The Trapnell Scholarship – 100% of basic fees per annum, plus books, meals, limited uniform, dental insurance and accident insurance. (*Applies to UK boarding students only.*)

The Jackson Scholarship – Up to 80% of basic fee per annum (means tested scholarship) plus books, meals, limited uniform, dental insurance and accident insurance. (*Applies to UK boarding students only.*)

The Lugard Bequest – 100% of basic fees per annum, plus books, meals, limited uniform, daily bus travel, health insurance, dental insurance and accident insurance.

BENEFACTORS SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

Trapnell Scholarship

The generosity of Mr. R.L. Trapnell, who was educated at Rossall from 1921 to 1927 and thereafter at King's College, Cambridge, has made it possible to offer a scholarship for a pupil aged 11, 13 or 16 from either a state or independent school, who can demonstrate outstanding academic ability, particularly in Mathematics and/or Science, and wishes to enter Rossall. The award covers the full basic fee for boarding pupils, plus certain extras, including School uniform and replacement uniform in subsequent years.

Jackson Scholarship

Mr. E. D. Jackson, educated at Rossall from 1918 to 1922, has made it possible to offer a Scholarship, for a pupil wishing to enter the School as a boarder. The award covers up to 80% of the full boarding fees plus an allowance for extras, uniform and travel. Parents of Jackson Scholars will make a contribution each term dependent upon their means which will be assessed annually. The purpose of this contribution is to support the Jackson Scholarship Fund for the benefit of existing and future scholars. Selection for this scholarship will be based as much on character, personality and range of interests as on academic ability.

Corlett Bursary

This Bursary was founded by an Old Rossallian and former Council member, Mr G L Corlett. This Bursary is normally made available to candidates entering the Sixth form for a two year course.

Newell Scholarship

This Scholarship was founded by an Old Rossallian, Colonel Newell, for pupils from the U.K. or Kenya. Personality and a wide range of interests are the main criteria for this award. Great importance is attached to the present Head's report and performance at interview.

Watson-Smith Scholarship

The Scholarship was endowed in memory of the late Mr. K. C. Watson-Smith and is available to pupils from Rossall Junior School or other independent preparatory schools. Successful candidates will be "pupils of noble character, who by their outstanding efforts of diligence and perseverance are worthy of encouragement".

Governors' Academic Awards

These awards are made available by the Council of Rossall School for candidates' entry to the Lower Sixth Form for a two-year course to A Level or International Baccalaureate Diploma and cover up to 20% of the basic fee.

Rossall School Foundation Bursary Awards

A 100% means tested Foundation Bursary will be available to any child who has exceptional talents in areas such as academia, arts, music and sports.

This Bursary is for the two years of Sixth Form as a day pupil studying A Level or the International Baccalaureate Diploma.

The scholarships and awards outlined above are not guaranteed year on year. They are awarded as and when the trust fund income allows.
