Rossall Summer School has always been a popular intensive language programme combined with enriching activities, specialised skills and cultural experiences since its beginnings in 2010.

After ten successful years, Rossall Summer School 2020 introduced the following for this year: additional trips, new specialist skills and more cultural experiences as it continues into a new decade.

However, the current situation with regard to Covid-19 has allowed Rossall School to have a rethink with regard to its Summer School programme and develop an Online English Programme for pupils to enjoy over the summer and develop their English skills.

We recognise that there is a demand for English learning during the Summer holidays. In the current situation, Rossall School is superbly well placed as a recognised Summer School provider to offer pupils a high quality of online English teaching and learning over the Summer.

Since March 2020 Rossall School has been delivering online lessons to pupils between the ages of 4 and 19 across over 40 countries and various time zones. In early May, the school had delivered over 10,000 lessons successfully as well as run online assessments and our own Rossall Diploma programme for key year groups who had missed out on taking important exams this year.

This experience and the knowledge is why we are confident that we can deliver a high quality Summer School course online during the summer months.





# AGE

Our Online English Language Programme is for boys and girls between the ages of 12-17 with English levels of B1 and above.

#### DURATION

Pupils will need to sign up for a minimum of two consecutive weeks as would have been the case had they attended the usual programme. This will ensure that pupils derive real benefit and sustained learning across a number of weeks giving them effective exposure to the English language and developing all aspects of their English ability.

Current and prospective pupils wishing to join Rossall School in September are also recommended to sign up for this programme. This will help students with their English language skills in preparation for the start of term.

# **CLASSES**

Our online classes will never exceed six pupils in a lesson and students will be allocated to a class according to age and language ability.

Pupils will receive ten hours of English as an Additional Language tuition per week from fully qualified Rossall teachers as well as group sessions throughout the week; this will mean that over the course of any one week all pupils will have had the opportunity to experience 15 hours of focused English learning.

By the end of their online learning course the pupils will have:

- Developed their knowledge of grammar and vocabulary
- Developed confidence and accuracy in speaking
- Improved their writing, reading and listening skills

At the end of pupil's time on a course, pupils and their parents can join a Certificate Ceremony where pupils will be presented with an

E-Certificate to recognise their attendance and completion of their course.





# **TECHNOLOGY**

Pupils should have access to a Zoom account: all lessons for that week will have the same link and be conducted on Zoom. Pupils will be given instructions on Monday morning when the first meeting of all pupils and teachers each week will take place, although a list of class requirements and set up instructions will be emailed to parents with the acceptance letter for a course when booked. Please ensure the account name is listed as your child's first name and last name. It should also include the country your child will be accessing the lesson from.

# COST

A week of online learning costs £395 per student. There are no booking fees, but payment is due on booking of the preferred week / course.

## DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

This week will allow your child to develop their skills within this increasingly important subject area. The broad learning intentions include developing a perspective on technology such that pupils develop a view of technology and how it might be used. This course will prepare students to participate confidently and successfully in an increasingly technological world. Students will gain awareness and learn from wider influences on Design and Technology.



# ADVANCED ENGLISH

Students will learn the basic structure and style of an academic essay, how to read English texts more critically, how to use these ideas in their written and oral arguments, what to listen out for in lectures and documentaries, and how to take useful notes. Students will gain confidence in group discussion work and how to give a formal presentation. Alongside these aims, the students will focus on improving their grammatical accuracy in speaking and writing, and extending both their general and academic English vocabulary.

Parents will be sent a list of requirements for tools and stationery, before the booked week so your child is aware of what they need to bring to each activity session. It is important your child is ready to start these sessions five minutes before the start time to maximise the time available for all pupils booked onto these courses.

# CLASS AND PROGRAMME RULES:

- You need to set up a suitable study area in your home. It needs to be a quiet space with a table and work surface for your device and other equipment.
- On the first day of each week, there will be an introductory session, which all pupils must attend to make introductions each week.
- All pupils will be registered in each lesson through a screen shot function.
- Parents should email the class teacher if their child is unwell before 8.45am (BST/UK time) each day.
- A break for all pupils in each class will take place every day between 11:00 and 11:15am for all pupils in each class to chat with each other between Lesson 2 &3
- Each day at 12noon there will be an option for pupils to request a slot with their class teacher for individual help and support.
- During each Wednesday and Friday morning, there will be options for group/open sessions for pupils to ask questions of each class teacher and each other.
- Your microphone must be muted during class time at the beginning of each lesson.
- You should also mute your device to prevent noise interference e.g. notifications etc.
- You must keep your camera turned on.
- You are expected to conduct yourself according to classroom expectations.
- A pupil's Zoom name must be first name and last name only as well as the country they are accessing the lessons from.
- Devices that are acceptable for online learning include a desktop computer, laptop and iPad only. Mobile phones are not acceptable.
