UNIFORM POLICY

Rossall students are expected to look smart at all times during the School day.

As a standard, the following is expected:

Uniform and Appearance

1. Full school uniform should be worn at all times; this includes games kit as stipulated at the appropriate times. Hoodies do not form part of the school uniform.
2. Hair should be clean, neat and tidy, without artificial colouring or extremes of style. Boys should be clean shaven and hair should not come below the collar or fall across the eyes. Girls' hair should be tied back whenever school uniform is worn. Sixth Form girls may wear their hair down if not directed to otherwise.
3. All pupils' shoe wear must be flat, polishable and black.
4. No jewellery may be worn, with the exceptions of: – one plain ring (all), one pair of sleepers or stud earrings (girls), a plain necklace. Discreet make-up is allowed Senior School girls only at the discretion of Houseparents.
5. Official school games kit should not be worn at any time other than for sports based activities or when permission has been given by a member of staff.
6. Clothing and shoe wear should be clean and in good repair.
7. Day and Boarding boys, Years 7 – 11, are required to wear;
 - Rossall Blazer with school motif (must always be worn unless otherwise instructed)
 - Rossall V-necked sweaters with school motif (optional, but must be worn with a blazer)
 - Plain white shirt (tucked in and top button fastened)
 - Rossall House tie
 - Charcoal grey trousers (tailored cut)
 - Dark grey socks
 - Rossall Reversible Stormproof for Years 7 to 11; Rossall cagoule/ wool overcoat for Years 9 to 11 may be worn as may a Rossall fleece scarf for Years 7 and 8 and the college scarf for Years 9 to 11. No other coat or scarf is permitted.
8. Day and Boarding girls, Years 7 – 11, are required to wear;
 - Rossall Blazer with school motif (must always be worn unless otherwise instructed)
 - Rossall V-neck sweaters with school motif (optional, but must be worn with a blazer)
 - Plain white blouse (tucked in and top button fastened)
 - Rossall House tie
 - Dark blue trousers
 - Rossall skirts (on the knee, or below)
 - Black/navy opaque tights
 - Rossall Reversible Stormproof for Years 7 to 11; Rossall cagoule/ wool overcoat for year 9 to 11 may be worn as may a Rossall fleece scarf for Year 7 and 8 and the college scarf for Years 9 to 11. No other coat or scarf is permitted.
9. Sixth Form, Day and Boarding boys and girls are required to wear;
 - Business type suits – navy blue, black or dark grey, plain material
 - The skirts should be “on the knee” and without a slit (girls)
 - Plain white shirts/blouses with conventional collar and House tie for boys
 - Black tights (girls)
 - Grey or black socks (boys)
 - Rossall Reversible Stormproof /Rossall cagoule/ wool overcoat may be worn as may a Rossall college scarf. No other coat or scarf is permitted.
10. Adjudication on uniform and appearance are at the discretion of the Senior Deputy Head.
