**P**ersonal: is to do with ourselves

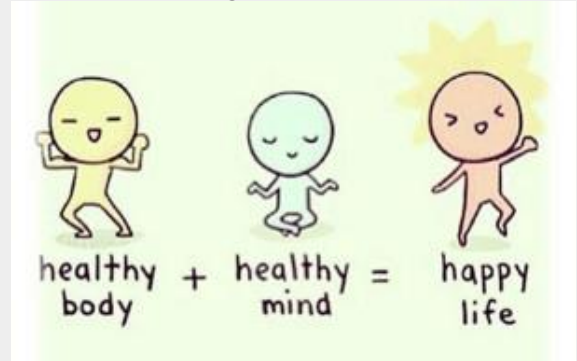
**S**ocial: the study of our interactions and relationships with others
